



## ALPHA WARRIOR HANDGUN 1.5 SKILLS TRAINING

### Overview of Course:

You will get firearm training in a professional, yet non-aggressive environment. The goal of this informative class is to obtain and practice skills relevant to everyday carrying of a handgun for personal protection. **THIS IS NOT A PERMIT CLASS.** This class will not allow you to legally carry a firearm in other states; **this is a skill class.** The first portion of this class will be dedicated to classroom instruction, during which participants are encouraged to ask any related questions. Following classroom instruction, on Saturday we will meet at the range location (Cedar gate Sports Club, to begin hands-on training and develop defensive shooting skills.

Overall, this class provides an outstanding foundation of knowledge and skills for those who want to use their handgun safely and effectively. While this is not a particularly high-stress or physically demanding course, we will train while moving, from a seated to a standing position, and other move-and-shoot drills.

This is a next step course from the basic handgun course. Shooters should have ideally attended a basic handgun course prior to attending this course. There are a number of quality basic courses offered by many trainers. Some recognized basic courses are the AW basic handgun course and any CLEET firearms block. Other basic courses will be approved on an individual basis. Please call to discuss. If you have not previously attended a basic handgun course, we will provide an optional two-hour classroom, dryfire, and range protocol session on the evening prior to the course. If you attend this evening session you can proceed to this course without a prior basic course.

The course of fire will require a **minimum** of 250 rounds of ammunition.

### Who can attend?

All U.S citizens aged 18 and up who are legally allowed to own/purchase/possess a firearm.

### Prerequisite

This is a semi-advanced class and should not be your first handgun class (You should attend our Basic Handgun class if you have never attended a class before). This should not be the first time you have fired the particular firearm(s) you intend to use in the class. You should have a more than basic understanding of handgun operation, use, and safety, and should know nomenclature, fundamentals, and how your handgun operates before this course.

### **This is NOT a concealed carry certification class.**

Concealed carry classes are designed to certify you to carry a concealed weapon in your state of residence (Not mandatory to carry a handgun in Oklahoma). Our training prepares you to carry and use your handgun in real-life situations; however, this is **not a certification class.**



## What is provided

- A non-intimidating and fun environment (this is not military tactical training:)
- Highly skilled and tenured instruction
- Lunch and Drinks (Saturday)
- Targets

## Course Learning Objectives

- Safety (First and foremost).
- Discussion, demonstration, and practical range exercises.
- Fundamentals of handgun marksmanship
- One handed shooting
- Malfunction drills
- Discernment drills
- Multiple target drills
- Use of cover and concealment
- Introduction to move and shoot
- Multiple timed drills
- Introduction to several standardized drills to help measure progress
- This course will have approximately one hour of classroom, and the remainder of the time will be spent on the range.
- All shooters will receive a list of recommended items after enrollment.

## Equipment Required

- **Reliable handgun. Semi-automatic or revolver. (We will not have handguns to borrow at the course.) You may bring more than one handgun if you want to train on different systems.**
- Eye and ear protection (Electronic preferred)
- Minimum of 3 magazines (4 preferred) if using a semi-auto
- Two-speed loaders if using a revolver (Three preferred)
- Two belt worn magazine pouches

### **Equipment Required (Continued)**

- One or more concealable holsters that securely fit the handgun, that hold the handgun at waist level, and remain open when the handgun is drawn. Inside-the-waistband, outside-the-waistband, or appendix carry is allowed. NO SHOULDER HOLSTERS, CROSSDRAW HOLSTERS, ANKLE HOLSTERS, BELLY BANDS, PUSH BUTTON SERPA HOLSTERS, OR HOLSTERS THAT CAUSE THE



HANDGUN TO BE POSITIONED PARALLEL TO THE GROUND. You may bring several holster systems to practice with and evaluate, as long as they meet the requirements above.

- Long pants with pockets and belt loops, **and a sturdy belt** (This is a critical part of the carry system). Please wear closed-toe shoes (no flip-flops or sandals) and no low-cut necklines. The hot brass will find its way to exposed skin. **We will be training and moving on crushed gravel.**
- Weather-appropriate clothing. (It may be hot and we will be in the sun most of the time. There is cover for breaks and reloading. We will have water and cold towels.)
- **A minimum of 250 rounds of (target or range) ammunition. NOTE: If the shooter is using a 357 revolver and is shooting 38 special ammo for practice, they need to bring at least 18 rounds of 357 magnum ammunition as well.**

### Recommended

- Personal comfort items (folding chair, water, snacks, **sunscreen**, etc.). Lunch will be provided.
- Bag for your equipment/personal items
- Any medicine or personal items you need throughout the day. Bring and specific foods needed.

**\*\*Bring your unloaded handgun and one empty magazine into the classroom. Semi-automatic handguns must have the slide locked open and no magazine in; revolvers must have the cylinder open and empty.**

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY LOADED MAGS OR AMMO INTO THE CLASSROOMS. Leave all ammo in your vehicle.**
